

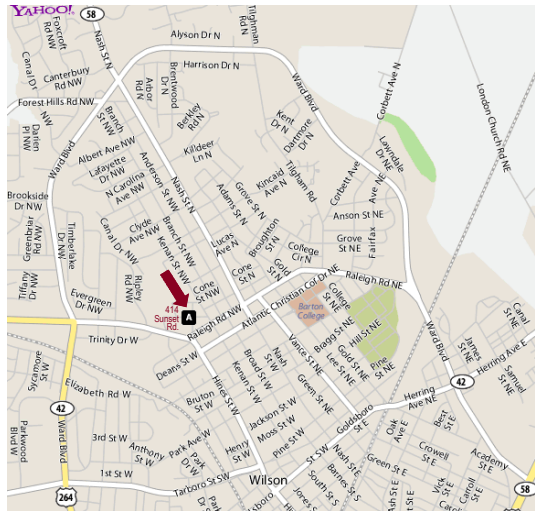
The Pastoral Counseling Service at First Presbyterian Church
